

Regulation No. 26
of the Rector of Gdynia Maritime University
of 6 May 2025
RRP/0132/26/2025

on the Amount of Tuition Fees for Full-time and Part-time Degree Programmes, and for Postgraduate Studies, including the MBA Programme, Conducted at Gdynia Maritime University, During the Academic Year 2025/2026

Pursuant to Article 23(1) of the Law on Higher Education and Science Act of 20 July 2018 (Journal of Laws of 2025, item 1571, as amended), and Statutes 77(1) and (3) of the Statutes of Gdynia Maritime University, in connection with Article 79 of the Law on Higher Education and Science Act of 20 July 2018 (Journal of Laws [Dz. U.] of 2024, item 1571, as amended), § 36 and 38 of the Regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 27 September 2018 on Studies (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 2787, as amended), § 10 of the Regulation of the Minister of Education and Science of 5 July 2023 on Doctoral Diplomas, Habilitation [post-doctoral] Diplomas and Doctoral Candidate Identity Cards (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 1422), and § 5(1) of the Regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 12 September 2018 on Documents Issued in Connection with the Course or Completion of Postgraduate Studies and Specialist Training (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1791), I hereby order as follows:

Section 1
Application Fee per Degree Programme

An application fee of PLN 85 is payable for each degree programme at the chosen level (bachelor's/master's) and mode (full-time/part-time) of study. The total fee paid must correspond to the number of degree programmes selected, as a separate fee is charged for each.

Section 2

1. The additional fees set for full-time degree programmes are as follows:

Fee for repeating a module – per hour	25 PLN
Fee for repeating a module – per 15 hours	375 PLN
Fee for repeating a module – per 30 hours	750 PLN
Fee for resuming studies to complete dissertation-related classes	500 PLN
Fee for repeating maritime internship (sea-going training)	In accordance with the cost incurred by the Faculty

2. In the case of multi-semester courses, the fee for repeating the course shall be payable in each semester in which the course is scheduled in the curriculum.
3. The fee for repeating a semester or academic year is:
- 1) as a single payment: by 30 October in the winter semester or by 15 March in the summer semester; or
 - 2) in instalments: 30 October and 15 December in the winter semester; 15 March and 15 May in the summer semester.
4. Fees for repeating a module (course) shall be paid in a single instalment on the first payment date in each semester.
5. In justified cases, the Dean may set an alternative payment schedule.
6. If the fee for repeating a module, semester, or year is not paid on time, permission to repeat or to study conditionally will be withdrawn. This may result in the consequences set out in the GMU Academic Rules and Regulations, including removal from the register of students.

Additional Fees for Part-time Studies or Postgraduate Studies (Non-Degree)⁸

1. The additional fees set for part-time studies and postgraduate studies are as follows:

This may result in the consequences set out in the GMU Academic Rules and Regulations, including removal from the register of students or doctoral candidates.

2. An application fee equal to 5% of the total tuition fee is payable separately for each postgraduate study programme. This fee is non-refundable in the event of the applicant's withdrawal. If the applicant is admitted, the amount of the application fee will be credited towards the first instalment of the tuition fee.

Section 10
Final provisions

1. Supervision of the implementation of this ordinance is entrusted to the Deputy-Rector for Education and Student Affairs.
2. The ordinance shall enter into force on 30 April 2025.
